

Make Your Own Seed Envelopes

Cut on the black outlines to separate the three envelopes.

Fold up the blank back of the envelope and fold the two side flaps over the back.

Glue the side flaps on top of the back. Make sure there are no holes for seeds to escape. Let dry.

Label the envelope with the kind of seeds and the date collected.

Fill the packet with seeds and seal the top with glue or tape.

Keep until next year or give away as a gift.
